How whānau can help



Make sure your child's records and emergency contacts are up to date. Wait for notification from authorities to enter the school in the event of a Lockdown.

Plan who is going to pick up your child.

If your child has medication during the school day, make sure we have enough medication for your child for at least one day.

Have your own emergency plan.

A separate emergency plan will be developed for activities that take place outside our grounds.
